# Forest Industry & History Tour

\$95 per person June 26 & June 28 8AM - 5:30PM

Start by heading south to the RoyOMartin Plywood & Solid Wood Plant at Chopin, to watch the production of timbers. From there, we will go to the Southern Forest Heritage Museum at Longleaf where lunch will be provided. This museum features the only complete early (1884-1957) sawmill site in the USA as well as several sub-museums on historical and geographically relevant topics. Included is also a historical train ride which provides an overview of the entire site. The return trip to Shreveport will feature a drive through historic Natchitoches, TX, and a visit to International Paper's containerboard mill at Campti, LA, where we will learn how raw material from the forest is converted into paper.

Must be abe to climb up and down ladders at manufacturing facilities for this tour.

### **Coffee in the Gardens**
